I am sitting at the departure gate at Heathrow airport waiting for the airplane that will take us on the final leg of our journey back to the USA, at the end of a wonderfully exhausting tour of Scotland. I can't speak for the others on the tour, but for me, these past 10 days making our way around some of the most beautiful scenery, the most historically fascinating sites, and the most temptingly attractive tourist shops, I have found myself pondering, on more than one occasion, what the word "home" really means.

Scotland is, in one respect, my home country. I was born there and spent the first 39 years of my life there. I can't alter that, even if I wanted to (which I don't.) In terms of it being my place or origin, Scotland will always be my home.

During our tour, our group visited several places in Scotland where I had stayed, including Greenock, the town where I was born. We saw the church which I called my church home as a child, and the church I pastored while ministering in Scotland. Each of these places represents, in a small way, some of what home is.

Now, I'm at gate C53 in Heathrow airport waiting to board a British Airways flight to Cincinnati, OH and in a few short hours, I will conclude my journey to Ross, OH and finally see my wife, daughter and the numerous other occupants of my home, and I will be HOME. So, "home" can have a multi-layered, many-faceted meaning. A place of origin, a place of rest, a place where the important people in one's life share our space and heart – all fit together to make each one of us uniquely who we are. What this trip has shown me is how much I appreciate the home I have found with my family in Ross.

I have shared previously that I have a painting which was given to me by my parents-in-law. It's called "Keepers of the Promise" and it has been my intention to hang it in our home. Not just in a house we live in, but in our home. At the end of this journey back to Ross from Scotland, one of my first tasks is going to be extricating the painting from its place in storage and hanging it in in the place we can finally call "home."
