May You be happy. May You be well. May You be safe. May You find comfort. May You have strength. May You have courage. May You find healing. May You have peace. May You have joy. May You be filled with loving kindness.

MAY YOU BE BLESSED TODAY



As I write this, the weather outside is sunny and warm (relatively speaking.) While that might not normally be all that remarkable as we enter the month of May, this year has already proven itself to be a bit unpredictable as far as weather goes. The uncertainty of winter has left us all, it would seem, keen to move on to embrace the new life of spring. And already I'm hearing people begin to anticipate the basking days of summer. Just a word of cautious wisdom to those going on the Scotland trip in June – Scottish weather is even less predictable than Ohio weather, so there might not be an abundance of basking! Anyhow, before we know it, it'll be Christmas!!

All of this seasonal uncertainty has made me think of the cycles we follow in the church year. There's some comfort in knowing that, no matter what the weather outside may be telling us, the liturgical patterns of the church seasons offer us a framework within which we tell the story of the Good News of how God sent Jesus Christ to redeem a fallen humanity. At the moment, we are in the season of Easter, during which time we hear again the awe-inspiring story of resurrection and new life. With each step we take through the church year, we discover again the boundless grace and mercy shown to us by God. There is never a day goes by that we cannot turn to God and know that there is Good News to be found in the story that is our walk with God.

This focus on the Good News is all the more important the more we realize how much we seem to be surrounded by bad news. It seems that the news media is fixated on bringing us as much of that stuff as it can get its hands on. And we, in turn, seem content to let them feed it to us. For example, I watched with dismay during the coverage of the events on New Years Day this year, when a Tesla Cybertruck was bombed outside a hotel in Vegas. The news outlet looped a 5 second piece of security footage showing the blast, over and over again without interruption, until I realized that I had watched the same truck being blown to smithereens at least a couple dozen times, and I was becoming desensitized to it. I had to snap myself out of it and change the channel. I don't want to minimize the horror of such events. But I also feel that we are in danger of becoming over-exposed to horror, and as a result we're becoming numb to its effect.

As we begin to enjoy the change in the weather, may the coming of spring serve to remind us of the hope of the Gospel – the Good News that Jesus Christ is risen and that, even in the midst of the brokenness and dysfunction that we see around us in society, God's love extends farther than any bad news can, and God will have the final word – and it is good.

Calling all VBS volunteers!




