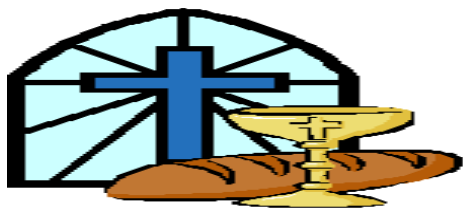

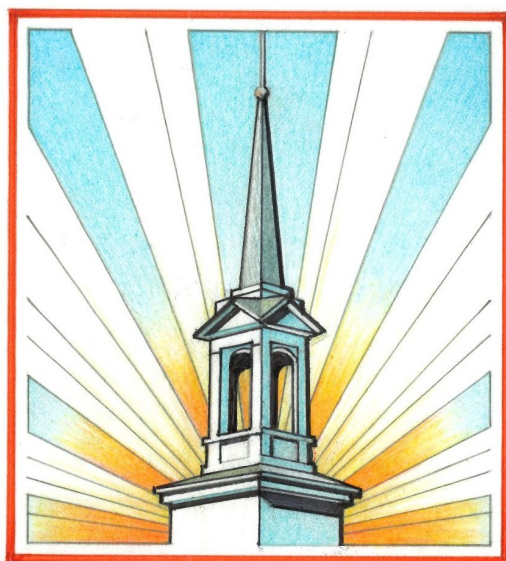

Pastor's Musings

This year, Easter falls quite early, meaning that Lent will be starting in the middle of February with the Ash Wednesday service on February 18th.

Even though we'll be leaving the season of Epiphany, we should carry the light of Epiphany into our Lenten journey. While many see Lent as a solemn – maybe even dull – season, we should never lose sight of the fact that we are light for the world (Matthew 5:14) and we carry the Light of the world (John 8:12) with us wherever we go – even into the recesses of self-examination during Lent.

I'm doing something a little bit different this Lenten season. We will be holding Wednesday lunchtime services throughout Lent. We'll meet at **12:15** in the fellowship hall (after the preschool leaves) and we'll have a short, informal gathering during which, we will look at the Sermon on the Mount from Matthew's gospel, and specifically about how it informs our lives today, in the world we find ourselves.

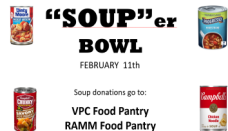

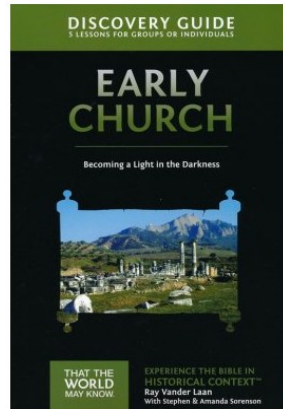

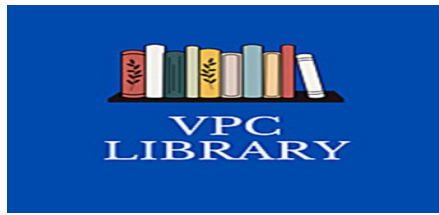
